Radiology department

Recent investment in new equipment and computer systems means that the Winfield diagnostic service is of the highest standard. The department is managed by experienced clinical staff and assistants and fully supported by 11 Consultant Radiologists.

The new Radiographic Information System (RIS) coincides with a refurbished X-ray suite in the hospital; a new paperless patient information system and a Patient Archiving and Computer system (PACS) which allows immediate access to patient images in the consulting rooms and theatres.

MRI and CT services are managed by Ramsay Diagnostics UK and appointments are available on a regular service. The company has recently installed the first 64-slice CT Scanner in a

mobile unit in the world. This provides high definition, fast imaging and an extended range of CT imaging services (see below).

For general radiography, such as chest and limbs, appointments can be offered as early as the day of referral. Reports are usually provided within 48 hours. For other procedures, depending on the speciality, an appointment will be offered within five days and reports sent to the GP.

GPs can also refer patients directly for MRI and CT scanning. Forms can be obtained from the Radiology Department and referrals will be accepted by post or fax. The direct Fax number is 01452 382130.

Pathology

A phlebotomy and pathology service is available routinely for all patients via the Outpatient Department. The service is provided by the local NHS Trust.

Direct Access Endoscopy

Winfield Hospital offers a direct access GP referral service for Gastroscopy and Flexible Sigmoidoscopy. Appointments can be made via Theatre on 01452 337243 or Fax 01452 331200.

Alternatively, the GP can refer to a specified consultant who will see the patient for an initial consultation prior to diagnostic procedures.

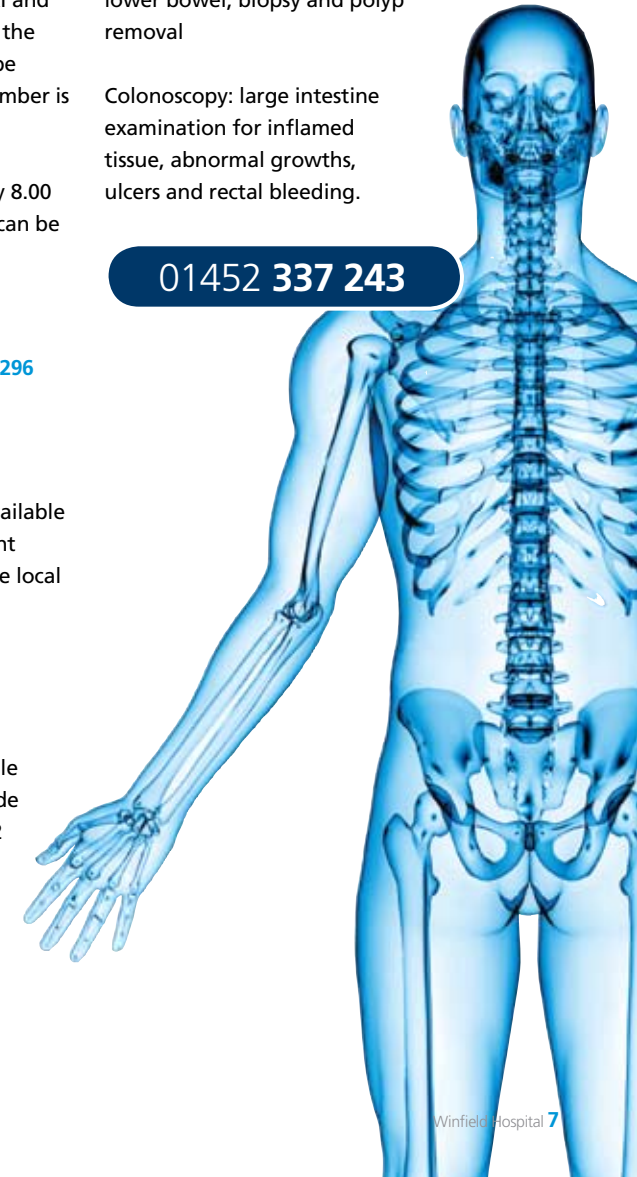
The Endoscopy Department is fully equipped to offer the following procedures:

Gastroscopy: examination of the oesophagus, stomach and duodenum

Sigmoidoscopy: examination of the lower bowel, biopsy and polyp removal

Colonoscopy: large intestine examination for inflamed tissue, abnormal growths, ulcers and rectal bleeding.

The busy outpatient department comprises 11 private consulting rooms, including specially equipped ENT and ophthalmology rooms, and two treatment rooms. It is used by over 90 consultants covering 27 specialities (these are detailed within the Consultant list). On average the department receives around 400 patients each week and performs over 250 procedures (these being both nurse and consultant led).

The department is open Monday to Friday 8.00am to 8.30pm and regular Saturday mornings.

We strive to offer a very high standard of customer care and treat everyone with personal respect.

Private patients are given appropriate appointment times for their need, and the hospital operates a relevant chaperone service whenever required. Patient education is important and information leaflets are available as appropriate.

The physiotherapy department is staffed by a team of dedicated and experienced Chartered Physiotherapists. The department currently offers seven treatment rooms and a large well equipped gym.

All physiotherapy patients have a treatment plan formulated at assessment and goals are renewed regularly throughout the course of treatment.

Referrals for insured patients are accepted from GPs and/or Consultants. Self Paying patients may refer themselves for physiotherapy, and tailored packages of care can be provided for those with long term rehabilitation needs. A referral letter is, however, requested where possible.

We aim to see urgent referrals within 48 hours of referral and non urgent referrals within five working days. Discharge reports are sent to the patient and their GP or Consultant when the treatment has been completed.

With some 4,000 operations carried out in the last year, and the increasing number of NHS patients accessing our facilities, the investment in a new, third operating theatre is a further advantage for those choosing Winfield services. Adjoining the theatres there is now a larger Recovery Area for better, more efficient immediate post-op care. There is also a new 6 bedded Day Ward facility for minor procedures. The department is well staffed with a dedicated team of skilled and experienced professionals.

Each of the theatres has a laminar flow system which changes and filters the air hundreds of times a minute, ensuring that all operating environments reach or exceed European standards of cleanliness. In addition the Winfield boasts its own purpose built TSSU which means that all equipment is autoclaved and sterilised on site. A Consultant Microbiologist works with the Hospital Infection Control Team to report and advise on all relevant issues in order to maintain the highest levels of cleanliness.

State of the art equipment within the theatre suites include an image intensifier, a microscope for ENT use, along with new laser and endoscopy equipment.

Winfield Hospital has in-patient facilities for 40 patients along with a new 6-bedded Day Ward for minor procedures such as ophthalmology, endoscopy, varicose veins and pain control.

We like to treat all our patients as guests and hope that their stay with us is as pleasant as possible. Premium Care patients always have their own room with en-suite facilities, a la carte menus, Wi-Fi internet access, complimentary toiletries and daily newspaper, as well as a visit from a representative of the management team.

All patients must be admitted under the care of a Consultant. A Resident Medical Officer is available on site for 24 hours medical support. We have senior nurse managers and senior nurse specialists for plastic and orthopaedic surgery and all patients are looked after by fully qualified nurses, supported by trained healthcare assistants.

Preventing infection is a key part of delivering good clinical care and both the housekeeping and nursing teams receive regular training to understand the importance of hygiene and infection control.

At less than 0.2%, Winfield Hospital has one of the lowest infection rates in the UK. (Hospital acquired infection rates nationally is 9.0%).

Occasionally we accept patients who have MRSA but they are nearly always transferred from another hospital or nursing home and are nursed in isolation until they are free from infection. All our facilities are regularly inspected and approved by the Care Quality Commission.



Winfield Hospital Pharmacy provides a full pharmaceutical service to all hospital departments. The Registered Pharmacists are available to dispense any inpatient and outpatient private prescriptions issued to Winfield Hospital patients. A medicines' information service is offered to staff and consultants and we endeavour to advise all patients on their medicines as appropriate.

8.30am – 4.30pm

The hospital has an arrangement for any urgent Pharmaceutical service required outside of these hours.



Cosmetic Surgery

Winfield Hospital is the main provider of cosmetic and plastic surgery in the Gloucester area and we have established a very positive reputation as such. We appreciate the importance of patients having realistic expectations about cosmetic procedures and making properly informed decisions. Our aim is for patients always to feel supported but never pressured, and to ensure that patients are fully aware of the risk and benefits of all procedures. We ensure that the consultants chosen by patients will receive continuity of their care from the initial consultation, through surgery and all follow up care.

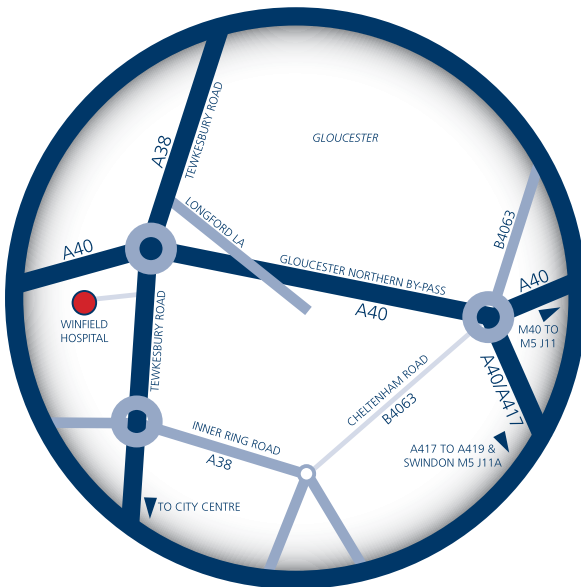
