Consultant Interventional Cardiologist

Dr Reto Gamma graduated in medical sciences from the University of Berne, Switzerland in 1997. After completing his General Medical Training at La Carità Hospital in Locarno, he undertook his specialist training in Cardiology at the Swiss Cardiovascular Centre, University Hospital Berne, Switzerland, from 2001 to 2005. The Centre performs the highest volume of Coronary Angiography and Angioplasty procedures in Switzerland, as well as being an internationally recognised centre of excellence for all cardiac invasive (including percutaneous PFO and ASD closure and pacemaker insertion) and non-invasive modalities (including imaging and electrophysiology). The Swiss Cardiovascular Centre is also highly renowned for its extensive research activity in all areas of cardiovascular medicine.

In 2005 he was appointed Research Fellow and Specialist Registrar at King's College Hospital in London, where he continued both his research activities, publishing in the field of coronary intervention, and refined and advanced his interventional skills. He was appointed as a Consultant Cardiologist at Broomfield Hospital, Chelmsford in September 2006. He performs his angioplasty and stenting procedures at the Essex Cardiothoracic Centre, where he treats patients from the whole of the Essex area.

His special areas of interest include diagnosis and treatment of coronary artery disease, balloon angioplasty and stent insertion, cardiac risk assessment, and permanent pacemaker insertion. He is also interested in the management of cardiomyopathies, heart failure and arrhythmias.

Dr Gamma is fluent in German, French and Italian. He is married and lives with his wife and baby son in Leigh on Sea. As well as spending time with his family, he includes skiing, cooking and playing the piano amongst his hobbies.
