## Aquablation for Enlarged Prostate

The Berkshire Independent Hospital is delighted to have been the first hospital in Berkshire to provide a new treatment for men suffering from an enlarged prostate (benign prostatic hyperplasia), robotic aquablation.

Aquablation therapy is an advanced, minimally invasive treatment that uses the power of water, delivered with robotic precision, to provide best-in-class and long-lasting symptom relief, with low rates of irreversible complications, regardless of prostate size or shape. As it is unique and bespoke based on each patient's anatomy, the procedure precisely removes prostate tissue and as such preserves key anatomy for long-term quality of life. Patients benefit from faster treatment and a quicker recovery to normal activity.

NICE published a Medical technology innovation briefing in January 2023, noting that when compared to the traditional procedures, aquablation offers additional benefits including an increased ability to preserve sexual function and the potential for the procedure to be undertaken as a day-case. As of 14 September 2023 NICE have recommended Aquablation to be offered to all patients and be the treatment of choice.

The Berkshire Independent Hospital in partnership with our Consultant Urologists, Mr Chris Blick and Mr Philip Charlesworth, have successfully treated over 100 patients over the last year with excellent outcomes.

This procedure is available for all patients; Insured, Self-pay and NHS referrals via eRs.

First initial new consultations currently average 7-14 days across most services. For patients requiring surgery, average wait times are currently 4-8 weeks, with ALL patients being offered surgery within 18 weeks.
