Reading Urology Partnership is comprised of six consultants, each with his own particular field of excellence, covering all areas of urological sub-specialisation.

All six consultants hold substantive appointments at the Royal Berkshire NHS Foundation Trust Hospital in Reading.

Reading Urology Partnership also has a team of six Specialist Urology Nurses, as we believe that the best way to deliver high quality care is by moving from a single-handed approach towards multi-disciplinary care.

All Consultants offer general Urology services, but in an age of ever increasing complexity of modern medicine & surgery, each Consultant concentrates on a specific area of urology to ensure delivery of first class care.

Reading Urology Partnership perform all consultations, diagnostics and specialised out-patient procedures (excluding general anaesthetic) at 11 Kendrick Road, Reading or The Forbury Clinc, 23 Craven Road, Reading. For all patients requiring day-case or in-patient procedures (including general anaesthetic) surgery is performed exclusively at The Berkshire Independent Hospital.

Our six Consultant Urological Surgeons work with our team of six Specialist Urology Nurses to deliver the following urological investigations:

- All out-patient consultations
- Urinary flow assessment & Post micturition bladder volume scan assessment
- Urine analysis & Urine microscopy and culture
- Blood tests (inc. PSA, PCA)
- Urine Cytology / NMP 22
- 24 hour urine collections for stone formers
- Ultrasound Scanning by Consultant Uro-Radiologist
- Flexible Cystoscopy & endoscopic stent removal

- Trial Without Catheter, TWOC
- Intermittent self catheterisation, ISC and other catheter related problems
- Intravesical Bladder Instillations (BCG, Mitomycin, iAluril, Cystistat)
- Vasectomies & other local anaesthetic procedures
- Targeted TRUS & Prostatic Biopsies (after multiparametric MRI scanning)
- Intravesical Botox injections for Detrusor Overactivity
- Urodynamic Bladder Studies

Many of these tests can be performed on the same day as the initial consultation.
