Ramsay Health Care UK's response to COVID-19

With the support of our teams and Consultants, Ramsay Health Care UK has provided an outstanding response to COVID-19 and our support to the NHS has been invaluable. To provide an overview of what this contribution looks like, we have provided:

- Access to over **1,000** beds and **100** operating theatres across **33** Ramsay Hospitals.
- Over **500** items of kit and PPE to NHS Trusts.
- 210 Ramsay team members volunteered or were seconded into the NHS.
- Treatment to over **65,000** urgent NHS referrals.
- Undertaken over **50** new procedures including urgent cancer surgery and chemotherapy services.
- Over 120 cancer services provided to maintain access for patients.
- Carried out almost **50,000** MRI and CT scans.
- Welcomed 900 new Doctors into our hospitals to help ensure the optimum provision of care.

How we are supporting the Trust

The Royal Berkshire Hospital continue to host their Rheumatology and Dermatology Services from our Mansion House in addition to the Community Midwife Service.

Accessing Services

Appointments are available on the E-rs for Gynaecology, Urology, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Spinal, Pain Management and Ophthalmology. Availability is currently very good with first initial consultation within a few days followed by surgery within a few weeks. For patients that are suitable to be seen at our hospital we encourage you to use these service.

Our consultants are accepting new private insured patients who can request either a virtual or face to face consultation usually within 48 hours. For patients who do not have private medical insurance we welcome self-pay patients to contact our Private Patient Account Manager Andrew Capel.
