NJR: Ramsay Awarded for Commitment to Patient Safety by the National Joint Registry



Ramsay Health Care UK is celebrating after being named the first Independent Sector organisation to achieve National Joint Registry (NJR) Quality Data Provider status across all of its hospitals that provide orthopaedic services, with each

successfully reaching standards of excellence in a national audit programme assessing data quality.

The NJR monitors the performance of hip, knee, ankle, elbow and shoulder joint replacement operations to improve clinical outcomes for the benefit of patients, clinicians and industry.

The registry collects high quality orthopaedic data in order to provide evidence to support patient safety, standards in quality of care, and overall cost effectiveness in joint replacement surgery.

The 'NJR Quality Data Provider' certificate scheme was introduced to offer hospitals a blueprint for reaching high quality standards relating to patient safety and reward those who have met registry targets in this area.

Making a private referral online



In your browser go to ramsayhealth.co.uk/patientreferral.
Login with Username: Ramsayonline and Password: Ramsaygp



Select the Ramsay hospital that you wish to send the referral to from the drop-down list



Attach a copy of the referral letter by clicking on 'Select' and adding the file or copy and paste it directly into the form



Complete the remainder of the form noting the mandatory fields marked with an asterisk

If the consultant is unknown please select 'specialty referral only'



Once you have completed the form, press the 'Submit' button to send the referral directly to the Ramsay hospital



You see an immediate confirmation that the referral has been received (also sent by secure email) and the hospital processes the referral

Clinical Exclusion Criteria: Patients with an incapacitating disease that is a constant threat to life, Patients under 18 years of age or Patients who have an unstable mental condition and are receiving psychiatric treatment.
